Located right outside the hotel door and reported to be the largest producer-only farmer's market in the country, over 150 area farmers sell their wares around the Capitol Square. These include vegetables, flowers, and specialty products.

Enjoy a walk around the square complete with live music, coffee, and sweets. Find out for yourself why Saturday mornings in Madison are special.

Participants do not need to register to take part. Simply come to the Local Arrangements Desk (next to the Registration Desk) by 6:30 a.m. We'll get you back to the hotel within an hour's time.
